Have you heard of DPC clinics? DPC stands for Direct Primary Care. These clinics provide care for a monthly fee. They don't take insurance, but the costs are often reasonable, the doctors spend more time with patients, and often offer discounts on medication, EKGs, stitches or more. Each DPC clinic is unique so look at their websites and see what services they include.

Many of these doctors left the current way of practicing medicine because they were fed up with the bureaucracy, the endless clicking of computerized checklists, and the seven-minute visit they were allowed to have with patients.
