## **Support American Dream not Dependency Dole**

Congress should not be so quick to protect Medicaid. Medicaid creates dependency and limits individual initiative. Being on the dole limits the recipient's use of their brains and body in creative and productive work. Second, one-third of America's doctors refuse to see new Medicaid patients because the pay is low and bureaucratic headaches are high.

Third, a study found that Medicaid patients had no better outcomes than uninsured patients. And fourth, every Medicaid recipient means fewer dollars in taxpayer's pockets and pushes us closer to government healthcare-for-all. Congress should support individual freedom, better patient care, and a chance at the American Dream for all.
