## **Avoid the Hospital if Possible; Go if Essential**

If you get Covid, try to avoid hospitalization. Be sure you get monoclonal antibodies BEFORE you get admitted since the FDA doesn't allow them given to inpatients. Unfortunately other effective, safe, treatment is difficult to get and remdesvir too often causes kidney failure.

Today's patients are made vulnerable because hospitals are corporate-run, not physician-directed. Families often aren't allowed to stay so there's no real patient advocate. Because federal payments for Covid patients on ventilators are three times higher than for patients not on ventilators, you might be put on a ventilator unnecessarily.

So, go to the hospital if you're having difficulty breathing or other serious symptoms, but your family could consider seeking an injunction from the court for the right to stay with you. You need an advocate on your side.
