Dangerous Incentive to Intubate Patients?

Why do so many hospitals mercilessly pressure Covid patients to accept intubation? Why would Mayo Clinic's legal team work so hard to keep Dan Pisano from leaving their hospital, where he eventually died?

Maybe it's the money. Hospitals get \$3,200 for outpatient treatment, \$111,000 for non-complex inpatient Covid care, and \$450,000 for complex inpatient Covid care, such as intubation. Hospitals can also get a bonus up to \$90,000, for a total of \$540,000.

So, for 100 patients, hospitals would get \$32,000 if they were treated and sent home or \$55 million if they were admitted and intubated. Just think about that.
