Transfer from ACA Public Health and Prevention (PHPF) Fund \$2,000,000,000

- Page 884 – no use of AHRQ funds to promote gun control
- Page 884 – HHS must create a website to report use and transfer of PPHF funds
- Page 887 – reporting of certain ACA employees and contractors
- Page 889 – no Medicare funding for ACA
- Page 890 – striking all “alternative health” and inserting “integrative health”
- Page 891 – mandated reporting of all funds used by CMS for Obamacare exchanges
- Page 891 – mandated reporting of exchange data hub milestones and readiness
- Page 892 – no funds for the ACA “risk corridor” program
- Page 1589 – “qualified expatriate” “shall not be considered a United States health risk”

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
