What Officials are Not Immune from Liability?

The plan to use public health to eliminate your freedom began in earnest after 9/11. The CDC published a “model state health emergency powers act” just six weeks later. Twenty states passed it in whole or in part. You experienced those powers during Covid. Then in 2005, Congress passed the Public Readiness and Emergency Preparedness Act, the PrEP Act, to eliminate liability for harm during a pandemic.

There is no liability for disabilities, injuries, or loss of life due to any product manufactured or used to diagnose, mitigate, prevent, treat, cure or limit harm from a pandemic or epidemic. The only exception is for **willful misconduct**. What officials are not immune?
