Arbitrary and Capricious Exceptions

The federal judge that shot down the mask mandate said it was arbitrary and capricious because of its exceptions. People eating and drinking or feeling winded can take down their masks.

Thus, she wrote, “The Mandate makes no effort to explain why its purposes – prevention of transmission and serious illness – allow for such exceptions.” She added, “Since the CDC did not explain its decision to compromise the effectiveness of its mandate by including exceptions ... the Court cannot conclude that the CDC articulated a rational connection between the facts found and the choices made.”

So the CDC is not following science, not serious about the illness, or both.
