Cellphones Used to Track Lockdown Compliance

The CDC paid at least \$420,000 to track population movement using cell phones. The data was used to check compliance with lockdown measures. There were 21 things they planned to use the data for, including to examine the number of mobile phones grouped together each month to evaluate lockdown orders. They planned to track those who visit K-12 schools, and they would monitor adherence to state-level quarantine policies. The CDC also planned to correlate mobility and mass gatherings with rise in Covid cases.

And beyond Covid, they planned to research physical activity and chronic disease prevention. They could also evaluate biking versus walking. There's something very ominous about this, and Americans should not accept such surveillance.
