Ivermectin Available OTC in Tennessee

On April 22, ivermectin became available in Tennessee without a prescription. The bill making this possible was introduced by state Rep. Susan Lynn, and state Sen. Frank Niceley. Their bills are short and sweet, a mere 96 words. They both say “ivermectin suitable for human use may be sold or purchased as an over-the-counter medication in this state without a prescription or consultation with a pharmacist or other healthcare professional...”

Governor Bill Lee signed the bill on April 22. The last sentence of the bill gives the rationale. The act had to take effect as soon as it was signed into law because the “public welfare” requires it. Indeed. Ask your legislators to pass this bill in your state.
