Could Aspirin Have Cut COVID Deaths in Half?

Could aspirin have cut COVID deaths in half? It was a key treatment being used by doctors who were treating COVID correctly and early. Aspirin prevents blood clots. As a reminder COVID-19 is a clotting disease. In research published in April 2021, aspirin reduced the Covid patient's need for mechanical ventilation by 44 percent, ICU admission by 43 percent, and mortality by 47 percent.

Why did doctors send patients home telling them not to return unless their lips turned blue, but never told them to start taking aspirin to stop it from ever happening?
