EHR Used to Conduct Research Without Patient Consent

The electronic health record, or EHR, was imposed by Congress to control doctors and profile patients. The data industry uses it to generate profit. And it has become a tool to conduct research on everyone without consent.

The world's largest EHR is called Epic. It has created a "clinical and public health research platform" called Cosmos, which advises the federal government on all things related to Covid. The research platform "combines electronic health record data from over 140 million U.S. patients . . . from over 700 hospitals and 10,000 clinics."

The data includes 2.2 billion visits with doctors. You never consented. How's that make you feel?
