Let's Not Be Italy!

Coronavirus has killed more than 3,000 people in Italy, which has the second oldest population in the world. The country has issued 15 recommendations to decide who to save. Those with the “greatest life expectancy,” rarely the elderly, are prioritized. Italy has a national health care system.

Meanwhile, France had 89 deaths in just one day. What if it was July instead of March? An American doctor vacationing in France in July needed emergency surgery, but due to its national health care system, the hospital was out of money for the year. To save herself, she medivacked to the U.S. Socialized systems use global budgets to limit access to care. Patients with coronavirus would be less likely to live if America had a national health care system.
