M4A – Auto-Enrolling “Residents”

This is day six of Medicare for All. The bill requires an enrollment process with several stipulations:

- First, there must be a process for automatic enrollment of individuals at the time of birth, or upon establishment of residency in the United States.
- Second, the process must provide enrollment of all eligible individuals, which includes every “resident of the United States,” and whomever else the Secretary decides to make eligible.
- Third, enrollees must be given a Universal Medicare card for identification and processing of claims. But it must not include the Social Security number, which is understandable, but makes it handy for all those non-citizens that would likely be enrolled in this taxpayer-funded program.
