Feds Support Free Flow of Patient Data

Freedom requires privacy and ownership rights. But officials at the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, want patient data to flow freely. They want your data used for research and efficiency. They want the algorithms of artificial intelligence and predictive analytics to sift through the “very rich stew” of patient data. Patient consent isn’t mentioned.

Federal support for patient ownership of patient data appears limited to patients being able to get medical records when they want them, rather than stopping federal officials and large corporations from sharing and using their private data without consent. That’s not ownership. Find a doctor who won’t let anyone into your medical record. Go to JointheWedge.com.
