Real ID Deadline Extended TWO Years—Refuse REALID

Real ID is a violation of states' rights. State legislators long opposed it. But when the Obama administration lied and said people couldn't fly without it, most states caved.

But now, many Americans have figured out this is a federal control and tracking device—a national ID—and are refusing to get it. Others are clueless. Officials are concerned that millions will not be able to fly this October. To avoid a public relations disaster, the Biden administration has delayed the mandate until May 3, 2023.

I suggest you refuse the Real ID, get a standard driver's license, and use other acceptable ID to fly, like a passport. If too many people get the Real ID, expect it to be imposed for access to medical care, firearm purchases, registering at a hotel and much more. #RefuseREALID.
