Alaska Airlines Bans Senator for Violating Mask Policy

A Republican state Senator from Alaska has been banned from Alaska Airlines for violating its face mask policies. As a result, Republican Lora Reinhold was forced to travel 19 hours by road and ferry to reach the state capitol. She was determined to be there to oppose a bill extending the emergency powers of Alaska's governor to the end of 2021.

Sen. Reinhold is committed to securing #facefreedom and paying the price. For example, she's been booted out of her position of Chair of the Judiciary Committee. Her Facebook page shows a warrior dedicated to constitutional freedom, and many Alaskans love her for it. One of her videos has her standing before a display of bouquets sent to her from around the state and reading the messages she received.
