Georgia City Installs Communist Surveillance System

Using Covid-19 as an excuse, the city hall of Peachtree Corners, Georgia, set up a communist-style surveillance system. The technology counts people, monitors compliance with masking and social distancing, and alerts city hall staff of violations. No taxpayer dollars were used, but that was probably to get it quickly and quietly installed. The Israeli company that built it now has an office in Atlanta.

The city manager says this surveillance system could have wider deployment across the city and within workplaces in the future. Supporters dismiss privacy concerns because facial recognition isn't happening. Who believes it will stay that way? This is less about privacy than freedom. Citizens weren't asked for their consent. If it comes to your town, will you fight it or accept it?
