GOP “Surprise Billing” Bill Will Advance Single-Payer

FreedomWorks has a \$50,000 ad campaign calling on Republicans in Congress not to support surprise billing proposals that include government-set rates for doctors and “put America on a path toward a government-run single-payer system such as ‘Medicare for all.’”
