## Look Behind the Headlines of Covid Stories

A news headline claims that a woman probably got coronavirus in the bathroom of an airplane. But after reading the entire article, I have my doubts. This was an 11-hour flight from Italy to South Korea. Six of the passengers were diagnosed with COVID-19 upon arrival despite having no symptoms, but it took 14 days before this woman tested positive. They called it an asymptomatic transmission.

Apparently, the only place she took off her mask was in the bathroom. But if you've been listening to me, you know masks don't protect against this tiny virus. Furthermore, deep down in the article, it said her infection could've come from a previous exposure, longer incubation or "other unevaluated situations."
