Many Health Care Workers Refuse Vaccine

The U.S. COVID-19 vaccination program is faltering. Up to half of the health care workers in one California county and one Texas hospital will not take the vaccine. Sixty percent of nursing home staff in Ohio are also refusing the shot.

One health care worker says his biggest concern is the “lack of data and the quick development time” of the vaccine. Another, who described herself as “up to my neck in COVID for 10 months” thinks “healthcare providers are being used as guinea pigs to see how this goes.” Meanwhile, two health care workers in Alaska suffered life-threatening anaphylactic shock minutes after the first dose of the Pfizer vaccine.

Importantly, the COVID-19 vaccine has not yet been approved by the FDA. It only has emergency use authorization.
