Amazon Launches Virtual Care Clinic

Amazon tries to do things no one else is doing, or to provide a product or service better than anyone else is providing.

Amazon just launched Amazon Care, a virtual primary care clinic for their Seattle-based employees. It offers nurses for follow up home visits. It includes in-person services and telemedicine. The company expects Amazon Care to give employees “fast access to healthcare without an appointment, at the convenience of their schedules, at the preferred location (home, office, or virtual).”

If this catches on, expect it to expand beyond Seattle, and perhaps beyond their own employees to Americans around the country.
