Is Trump's Refusal a Strategy to End Lockdowns?

On October 6, President Trump shut down negotiations over COVID-19 spending until after the election. His team had been negotiating with House Speaker Nancy Pelosi throughout the summer and again in late September. But then two days later talks were back on track, including another round of \$1200 stimulus checks.

The President had previously agreed to a \$1.6 trillion infusion of cash, but Pelosi wanted \$2.4 trillion, which Trump says is for purposes unrelated to COVID-19, including to bail out Democrat-led states that are in trouble.

Here's a question: Would Trump's refusal to bailout Americans put pressure on states to open up and let people go back to work, to the delight of many Americans? Stay tuned. It's three weeks to the election.
