Did you see my tweet about a devastating moment at a funeral in England? A man with a wife and two adult sons had died. The video shows the very beginning of the service. Everyone is seated in their own chair six feet apart.

During the first moments of the pastor's welcome, the two sons moved their chairs to sit on each side of their mother. One put his arm around his mother's shoulders. Almost immediately, the funeral director entered into the room and loudly interrupted the funeral directing the sons to "move the chairs back." Another man who had seen the sons move had also started to move his chair closer to another family member, but he was stopped in his tracks. This is a crime against the family, the elderly, and the hurting. This is what COVID has come to: cruelty against the elderly.
