Restoring “Old Fashioned Medicine” –at Work

Acute medical care is branching out in unexpected ways. In June 2019 a group of employers in Baldwin, Wisconsin opened a clinic on the corporate campus of one business. It's called the Be Well Clinic. The goal, according to nurse practitioner Jamie Edwards is to “build relationships with patients and bring back ‘old fashioned’ medicine.”

The clinic, funded by the four businesses, will provide services to their employees, which include local school district employees. Free services include labs, medications and disease management.
