Hillsong Pastor Tells Churches to Defy Discriminatory Covid-19 Restrictions

During the COVID-19 lockdown, government officials are discriminating against churches. Meanwhile, protests and marches bring thousands of people coming together with no social distancing and no government sanctions, such as the Women's March in Washington, D.C. on October 17th.

Yet churches continue to be limited in attendance. In Australia, Hillsong's pastor urges churches to take a stand against the discriminatory restrictions. Churches there may have no more than 100 attendees no matter how big the building, while weddings are allowed to have 300 guests and thousands of fans can attend sporting events.

Who remembers the first line of a poem written by a German pastor: "First they came for the communists, and I did not speak out..." This discrimination against churches is happening in America and it is definitely time to speak out.
