## Is This a Pseudo-Pandemic?

In August, the New York Times said the PCR test for COVID-19 was being used incorrectly. Up to 90 percent of positive tests in three states are actually negative, without sufficient virus to infect anyone.

The PCR test is a problem. In 2006, a hospital thought it had a whooping cough epidemic. The PCR test found 142 “infected” workers. But no bacteria grew from the cultures. There was no whooping cough or epidemic.

In 2007, epidemiologist Dr. Trish Perl said the test is a problem and may cause more pseudo-epidemics. Yet PCR tests are being used today for COVID-19. Perhaps that’s why the New York Times did the study this year. But why has main stream media and government ignored this very important study about false positive results for COVID-19?
