Congress Pushes Digital IDs for All

Congressman Bill Foster's "Improving Digital ID Act" aims to establish digital IDs for all Americans. "There's just a long list of government uses once you have this ID" said Foster. He said those uses could range from electronic health records to voter identification. The bill would require establishment of national digital standards.

Language in his bill claims this will increase security and privacy for all Americans. However, the mandate to digitize medical records has led to costly and disabling ransomware attacks, and millions of breaches of patient data—breaches not possible in the world of paper. Digital records decrease privacy and security. Don't expect anything different with digital IDs.
