Hacked! Hacked! Hacked Again!

Last month 80 million accounts were hacked at Anthem Blue Cross. Now Premera Blue Cross had 11 million accounts hacked. Although Premera's data was encrypted hackers got in. Data accessed could include names, date of birth, Social Security numbers, addresses, bank-account information and health data.

A theory has emerged that "the Chinese are harvesting personal data on Americans whom they could target in spying operations." The FBI is investigating. Amazingly, Premera did not discover the hack until 270 days after it began. With 91 million records hacked, why is Congress pushing to make all our medical records online-accessible?
