Is Care or Coverage Most Important?

Let's start this new year with a question. Is care or coverage most important? Which one do you value the most? This is not a chicken and egg question. Your answer may demonstrate how today's debate is focused on the wrong thing, and why universal coverage is the drumbeat of socialized medicine.
