Facts about Obamacare and Congress

Here are some facts. First, Obamacare is government coverage obtained through a government exchange. Second, exchanges are not “marketplaces.” They are government websites created to redistribute worker’s wages through Obamacare subsidies. Third, taxpayers have paid over \$6 billion to build the exchanges. Fourth, Obamacare enrollment is less than half what was predicted. And fifth, if low enrollment through the exchange structure continues, the exchanges will fail.

Republicans should be happy that the Obamacare exchange system could collapse, but they’re preparing to establish their own wage redistribution system called **federal reinsurance**. Tell Congress to get out of health care or we’ll have socialized medicine in America.
