Governors Want Intrusive Obamacare Data System

The National Governor's Association has sent a legal memo to the President asking for access to a technology key to the federal takeover of health care. The Governors Association wants federal officials to give States the Obamacare information technology system the Feds are creating for the HHS-run federal exchange.

This data system would be used by state-run federal health insurance exchanges. It would share private data about individuals with the federal government, state officials, and employers to monitor and report on patients, doctors and citizens.

Such a system would speed up the takeover of health care in America — state by state. Just say no to any state-run, government-established health insurance exchange.
