Will Federal Mandates Make Insurance Unaffordable?

Last week, the feds issued a rule telling insurance companies what services must be offered in any Obamacare exchange policy. If going to the government exchange is your only option but you don't want to, or don't want some of these services or you can't afford a policy that covers these services, you will have to go uninsured and pay the IRS penalty.

Exchanges can only offer plans that include these services. This Obamacare coverage will be more comprehensive and more expensive than insurance today. Experts worry that people won't be able to afford coverage. You will either have to pay the price, go uninsured, or join a health sharing group.
