Government Healthcare NOT Private Insurance

The Obama administration says you can buy private health insurance on the government exchange. Not true. You may have a choice of Blue Cross Blue Shield, or Wellpoint or Kaiser, or your current health plan. It'll look private, but this is an illusion. This is government health care. These policies are under federal control. They must be federally-qualified. They are federally-subsidized. By 2014, they must follow federal rules, instead of state law like today.

You cannot buy one unless the federal government lets you. If the feds look at the data you submit to the Exchange and find something they don't like, you're out of luck. Exchange policies are government health care, not private insurance.
