Five Signs of Obamacare in Trouble 1

Here are five signs that Obamacare is in trouble. First, even though the law says insurers can't refuse anyone with pre-existing conditions, a new proposed Obamacare regulation has suddenly declared state-based high-risk pools for people with pre-existing conditions as "adequate coverage" even though the law prohibits it. Twenty-five of the 35 states that had this special state coverage have already dismantled it. Perhaps Obama has figured out that mandating coverage doesn't make it affordable.

Second, Vermont's plan to use Obamacare's \$45 million State Innovation grants as a path to single-payer has imploded. The \$2.5 billion cost proved impossible. Listen tomorrow for three more signs of Obamacare in trouble.
