Socialism in Training

Yesterday I discussed medical school training. Today let's look at the new test to get into med school. One school executive said curing disease used to be the focus of medical school, but "Now we have problems like obesity and diabetes that require doctors to form therapeutic alliances with patients and convince them to change their lifestyle."

Well, this is because in the new health care system -- where doctors aren't in charge -- doctors get paid less if their patients don't change. Thus the new test includes a section on social inequality, racial and ethnic identity, "institutionalized racism" and "power, privilege and prestige." One doctor called it "agenda-driven garbage." I call it socialism.
