Ruling to Reinstate Unvaxxed NYC Public Employees is Right Decision

ST. PAUL, Minn. — Reacting to the recent court news from New York, **Citizens' Council for Health Freedom** releases the following statement from Twila Brase, CCHF's president and co-founder:

“The tide is turning. Judge Ponzio’s ruling to reinstate all New York City public employees who refused to get the Covid shot with backpay is a win for truth and justice. Pfizer has now admitted the vaccine does not stop transmission and it’s been clear for nearly a year that the vaccine does not stop anyone from contracting COVID-19. The judge’s ruling underscored these facts.

“People lost their jobs, lost freedom of movement, and many were forced to participate in a medical experiment that they did not want to participate in because of the government’s vaccine mandate. New York City Mayor Eric Adams went further by declaring the vaccine mandate to be permanent, permanently terminating 1,400 public employees. In response, [Judge Ponzio issued a series of 12 orders](#) which included a list of the various wrongs committed against public employees. As injuries and deaths reported from the Covid-19 vaccination pile up, public employees can heave a sigh of relief that they escaped vaccine injury and they now have their jobs back.

“The vaccine mandate was wrong from the beginning. Today is a good day for health freedom, bodily autonomy, and the right of every individual to weigh the ‘vaccine vs. virus’ risk for themselves and make their own decision without government coercion.”
