OBAMACARE ACTION ALERT!

Act Today to Slow Obamacare Implementation!

Deadlines: Dec. 21 – Jan. 4

The Obama administration has given you just 30 days over the holidays to read more than **700 pages** of proposed Obamacare regulations which could then be finalized and have the full force and effect of law.

The Wall Street Journal says “many of the rules were approved in-house and ready to go as early as May.” But the Obama administration waited until the holiday season to spring them on you. It appears that the administration does not want you to know what's in the proposed rules or have an opportunity to oppose anything objectionable you may find – like the just discovered \$63/yr “head tax” on health insurance.

Please do two things:

- 1) Go to **regulations.gov** and search for "Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act."

Eight of the 12 pending rules that pop up with "Comment Now!" have due dates for comments before or by January 4. The earliest deadline for comments is **December 21**. The latest deadline for these eight proposed rules is **January 4**.

Make this simple comment on all 8 pending rules:

"You have not given the American public sufficient time to read, digest or respond to this proposed rule as required by the federal Administrative Procedures Act. I request that you extend the comment deadline by 60 days."

- 2) Contact your members of Congress by phone or email and ask them to stop the Obama administration from violating the federal Administrative Procedures Act which requires that the public be given sufficient time to read and respond to any proposed administrative rules.

The administration must respond to all comments, but it is only required to respond to comments provided. If the public provides none, or has no time to read and respond, the rules can be finalized with the full force and effect of law.

Please act as soon as possible.
