

TAKE ACTION!

Simple Task to Slow Obamacare!

ACTION REQUEST:

Ask for an extension of the 30-day public comment period on four proposed Obamacare regulations. Below is a comment you can use.

It's easy! Just go to each of the 4 the websites listed below, paste your comment in the "Type Comment" field, provide your country, state, zip code and category -- and CLICK "SUBMIT"

WHY:

The Federal Government has released for public comment **six** proposed Obamacare rules (federal regulations) totaling 871 pages. They were published on either November 26 or December 5 – right in the midst of the nation's biggest holiday season.

Four of the proposed rules -- totaling 745 pages – give the public just 30 days to respond with public comments to the proposals. Most of those 30 days -- ending either December 26, 2012 or January 4, 2013 (depending on the date of publication in the Federal Register) -- are during the busiest holiday season of the year (Thanksgiving, Christmas, New Years).

SAMPLE REQUEST:

Write the following comment, or better yet, a version of this comment with at least one personal statement in it (so they can't disregard it), or your own comment in the "TYPE COMMENT" space of each of the four proposed rule (website urls found below):

The public comment period for this proposed rule should be extended. Thirty days during the holiday is poor timing and not enough time to read, digest, or respond in writing to many pages of information. I request that there be an extension of the comment period to 90 days. Please inform me of this change.
