Fox in Charge of Health Care Hen House

Liberals in Congress put the fox in charge of the health care hen house and now they're worried.

ObamaCare says the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (the NAIC) must decide what is and isn't health care.

The minimum loss ratio section of the law requires a certain amount of every insurance premium dollar to be spent (or "lost") on health care. But insurers have a boatload of items they want classified as health care that are anything but. If insurers succeed, there will be less money available to take care of you.

On August 3rd, 47 members of Congress sent NAIC a letter expressing concern about the influence of insurers over the definition of health care. Isn't it just a little too late?
