Indiana Parents Sue on Baby DNA

A baby DNA lawsuit was in the Indiana Court of Appeals last month. A major news outlet is working on an article about it – I know that because they contacted me – and the ruling has yet to be issued.

The Indiana Department of Health has 25 years – more than 666 banker boxes -- of newborn Hoosier DNA, most of it stored without parent consent. Parents discovered this after a television station saw our press release about baby DNA storage in Minnesota, investigated and reported. The reporter found the Baby DNA cards of 2.5 million children, which the judges should now require the state to destroy.
