Hackers with Conscience Steal 10 Million Medical Records

Just four weeks after President Obama first took office, he signed a bill that required every doctor and hospital to have an electronic health record (EHR), or lose money on every Medicare patient.

In January 2024, hackers took 10 million medical records from a hospital. They said that they "purposely didn't encrypt" the data "so as not to interfere with patient care." Usually, hackers shut down the record system, which shuts down the hospital.
