Walmart is closing its 51 health centers. The company said it's not a sustainable business model. In other words, they couldn't make a profit. Insurers did not like to pay their bills. Also, Walgreens, which spent \$5 billion to get into retail health care, announced in March that it is shutting down 140 of its primary care clinics.

These struggles are likely due to the fact that health care is rife with self-interested third-party payers. What if Walmart had offered cash-based care only, at cash-based prices, with no interference from third parties? That's the kind of care everyone should have access to, along with medical indemnity insurance (real insurance) that pays the patient.
