Dr Jay Singleton owns an eye surgery center in North Carolina. But the state's certificate of need law, or CON law, limits the number of surgeries he can do. Thus, Dr. Singleton is forced to practice at another facility that charges patients four times as much: \$6,000 instead of his \$1,800.

CON laws let state officials limit the number of health care facilities. Large hospitals like these laws because they keep the competition out and the prices high.

In good news, the North Carolina Supreme Court sent his case back to the lower court to determine whether CON laws are unconstitutional. Of course they are. A win for Dr. Singleton is a huge win for freedom. Find other doctors working in freedom at JointheWedge.com
