Protect Your Child in the Exam Room

You may have been told to leave your teenage child alone in the exam room so he or she could be questioned by clinic staff. If that happened to you, did you refuse, walk out with your child, or leave the room under protest?

Just as attorneys are in the room during police questioning, parents should be in the room when clinics ask minor children about sexual preference, gender, drug use, family relationships, and more. The child's answers will be recorded forever in their medical record.

Parents have a right and an obligation to protect their children. Our organization, CCHFREEDOM.ORG, wrote a bill to give parents the right to stay in the exam room. It passed the House in North Dakota, but the Senate voted it down. Every state should pass this bill.
