STARK CONTRAST: Health Plans Win – Doctors Lose

Health care has hypocrisies. For example, hospitals deemed taxexempt, charitable non-profits are often the ones most likely to sue patients who cannot pay for the care they received. Health care systems claim they protect your privacy, but they share it liberally.

Then there's the federal Stark Law. Doctors are not allowed to refer patients to a facility they have a financial interest in. A California system has to pay \$32 million for violating Stark.

Yet health plans can own hospitals and doctors and send patients to their own facilities without violating Stark. Thus, the Stark Law prohibits doctors from doing what health plans do all the time when they insist you stay in-network or pay more. Stark enriches health plans and hurts doctors.
