Strike Shows "the Stripes" of Socialized Medicine

Tomorrow, doctors who work at the Allina health care system are planning to strike for 24 hours. If it happens, it will be the largest physician strike in the U.S.

Once upon a time, before government inserted itself into health care, doctors were happy, spent time with patients, discussed cases with each other, and made enough money to thrive and be charitable.

Today, nearly 80 percent of doctors have become corporate employees under corporate pressure. They face pay cuts, requirements to see more patients in less time, and oppressive government reporting requirements.

The strike shows how the health care system has been taken away from doctors by Congress and given to corporate business, whose focus is profit, not patients. This is the corporate version of socialized medicine.
