Vultures at the Gate?

The Consolidated Appropriations Act (H.R. 7148) has shocking language encouraging hospitals, transplant centers, and organ procurement organizations to integrate their data systems. It also asks hospitals to automate referrals of POTENTIAL organ donors to organ procurement centers, and it encourages hospitals to give these centers remote access to medical records of *potential* donors. Patients, not yet dead, with viable organs.

These centers have been known to push families to let their loved ones die before they even know if they will live. These centers should not be able to remotely watch and wait, like vultures at the gate. Ask your state legislators to forbid remote access and automated referrals. These patients need privacy, not pressure.
