REAL ID is Not Proof of Citizenship

If passed, the SAVE America Act will require more than a REAL ID to vote. Many non-citizens can get a REAL ID. Therefore, whether you have a REAL ID or a regular driver's license, you'll need a birth certificate or other documentation to prove citizenship.

The only REAL IDs you can use to register to vote will be Enhanced Driver's Licenses, issued by five states on the northern border. These indicate citizenship because they act as a passport between America and Canada.

Wrongly believing the REAL ID stops election fraud and lets you vote may cause more people to get the federal REAL ID, which is being digitized for biometric control.

Let everyone know the REAL ID does not prove citizenship and is not required to vote.
