HIPAA “Notice of Privacy Practices” is a Deception

As we end our Truth About HIPAA month, know this: HIPAA is not a privacy rule. It's a permissive data-sharing rule. HIPAA is a deliberate deception. To embed that deception, the rule requires clinics to try to get people to sign an acknowledgement that they've received or read the HIPAA “Notice of Privacy Practices.” But it's not a notice of privacy practices. It's a notice of disclosure practices. More deception.

Because it's called a “privacy rule,” most state legislators think HIPAA protects privacy, so they don't enact real state medical privacy laws. Ask your legislators to pass a state privacy law in your state to actually protect your medical privacy.
