Birthright Citizenship and the Constitution

There's a very important case coming soon out of the Supreme Court. *Trump v. Barbara* challenges President Trump's order to end birthright citizenship. Professor Edward Erler's speech from 2008 provides important facts on this critical issue. Find it in *Imprimis*.

As the professor notes, in the 14th Amendment, "there are two components to American citizenship: birth or naturalization in the U.S. and "being subject to the jurisdiction of the U.S."

Being subject to the jurisdiction means owing exclusive allegiance to the U.S. and none to any other country. Foreigners owe their allegiance to another country, not the U.S. The court should end birthright citizenship. Tell others about these two components and pray the court rules rightly.
